- Despite stating in Feb. 2001 that Saddam had not developed "any significant capability" regarding WMDs, and despite intense behind the scenes arguments about the accuracy of WMD charges, Powell made the case in front of the United Nations for a United States-led invasion of Iraq based on Iraq's possession of WMDs.
